

Devonian shallow-water-carbonates

Research in the Carnic Alps:



Dr. Susanne Pohler is currently involved in compiling a review of Devonian shallow water carbonates in the Carnic Alps in order to facilitate the establishment of a common stratigraphic nomenclature for both, the Austrian and the Italian side of the mountain range. This endeavour is part of a joint effort by an Austro-Italian research team coordinated by Drs. Carlo Corradini (Università di Cagliari) and Thomas Suttner (Universitaet Graz) and others. Some field work will be carried out in late July/August 2010 involving examinations of key locations.

Previous work included measuring of sections through various Devonian carbonate accumulations including Mt. Cellon , Mt. Findenig, Mt. Freikofel, and Mt. Seewarte to interpret the depositional environments of the various successions.
