Devonian shallow-water-carbonates

Research in the Carnic Alps:



Dr. Susanne Pohler is currently involved in compiling a review of Devonian shallow water carbonates in the Carnic Alps in order to facilitate the establishment of a common stratigraphic nomenclature for both, the Austrian and the Italian side of the mountain range. This endeavour is part of a joint effort by an Austro-Italian research team coordinated by Drs. Carlo Corradini (Università di Cagliari) and Thomas Suttner (Universitaet Graz) and others. Some field work will be carried out in late July/August 2010 involving examinations of key locations.

Previous work included measuring of sections through various Devonian carbonate accumulations including Mt. Cellon, Mt. Findenig, Mt. Freikofel, and Mt. Seewarte to interprete the depositional environments of the various successions.
